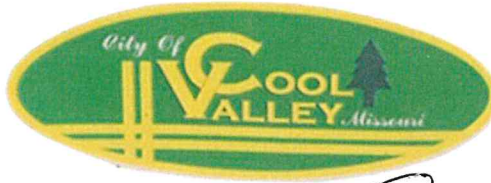


1. Approval of monthly bills for payments
