Dear Chief Sanders:

St. Louis County has reviewed our dispatching contracts and determined an updated pricing model is required to accurately account for costs going forward.

The current pricing model for dispatching contracts is based solely on:

- Directed calls for service
- Population

Following a detailed cost analysis, we have determined that the new pricing model must include the following:

- Directed calls for service
- Self-Initiated calls for service
- Population
- Dispatch software costs
- Dispatch building maintenance

Dispatch software costs and dispatch building maintenance will be divided proportionally based on a municipalities dispatching call load (Directed and Self-Initiated calls). This will be reevaluated for each renewal term for all dispatch agencies. This methodology, which includes the Unincorporated St. Louis County call load, directly ties your share of these costs to your service usage.

Self-Initiated calls will be calculated based on an officer keying up on the radio (per CFS) to put themselves out on a call. The Motorola CAD system allows us to differentiate between Field Initiated and Mobile. If an officer puts themselves out via their MDT there is no cost associated.
